Pana-View Blind Spot Mirror

Installation Instructions - Revised: June 14, 2019

Tools: None

Skill Level: Easy; Please read all instructions before starting.

- 1. Prepare mounting surface:** The working temperature should be between 70 and 90 degrees Fahrenheit. Clean the driver's side mirror glass using soap and water. Let dry. Use rubbing alcohol wipe to de-grease the glass surface. Let the glass and frame dry completely.
- 2. Prepare Pana-View Blind Spot Mirror:** Remove backing from all mounting tape.
- 3. Mount Pana-View Blind Spot Mirror:** Visually align blind spot mirror to door mirror glass. Lightly press blind spot mirror against glass. NOTE: It is very difficult to remove the blind spot mirror once set so make sure of alignment before pressing against glass!
- 4. Secure Pana-View Blind Spot Mirror:** Apply firm, even pressure over blind spot mirror surface for 30 seconds to ensure it is securely attached to glass.
- 5. Let set:** Wait at least one hour before exposing Pana-View Blind Spot Mirror to moisture or vibration. After 72 hours, the bond becomes almost indestructible. The 3M™ VHB™ tape has extremely high adhesion and will resist most solvents and temperatures up to 300 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 6. Test:** Take sufficient time to get used to the reflection provided by the Pana-View Blind Spot Mirror. Due to its complex shape there will be some image and spatial distortion. **Remember that objects in the mirror are closer than they appear.**
- 6. Enjoy!** The Pana-View Blind Spot Mirror will provide enhanced driving visibility in all environments and conditions.
